






OCTOBER FUNRAISER BOUTIQUE AND GAME NIGHT

"Changes in Seasons II. As for the inspiration for the pattern "Changes in Seasons II". First of all, Flying Geese are one of my favorite quilt units to make, and then also Geese use their "voice" to signal the change of a season to us as they fly south for the winter and north for the summer, much like my voice is signaling another change in this season of my life. The top and bottom rows of this quilt are based on the Choppy Flying Geese that I use in my Logo.




