Fellow Quilters:

As I mentioned at our last meeting, the primary role of a board is fiduciary. We started the year by improving our financial processes by moving the bulk of our savings into a higher interest paying CD (thanks Debbie Z.)!

The board to voted to move our accounting to Quick Books on-line. This streamlines everything from uploading receipts, documenting payments and even allowing reviews before reports are pulled. However, this software has a monthly fee of \$35. So how can you help?

First, if you haven't paid your dues already, please do so forthwith. Did you know our insurance is based on the number of members? Insurance is due by the end of September, and we need an accurate count.

Second, let's make this October fundraiser a blowout! Donate items to sell (make sure items are individually priced) and bring plenty of money to buy things (cash is best).

Finally, Debbie Zeller has asked to be relieved of her treasurer board role. We are looking for her replacement whom she is willing to train on what's expected.

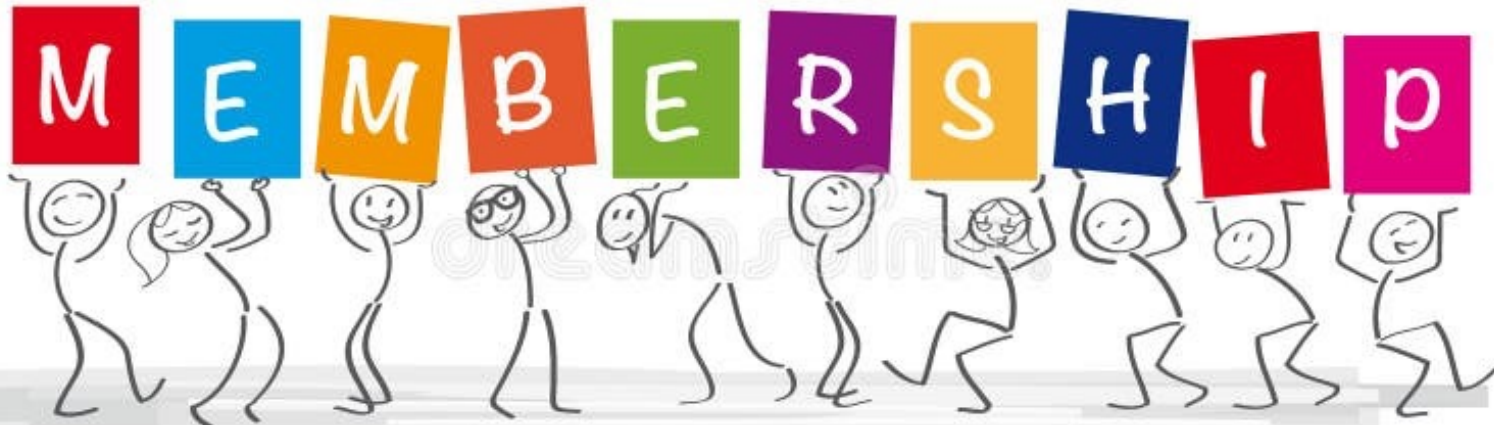

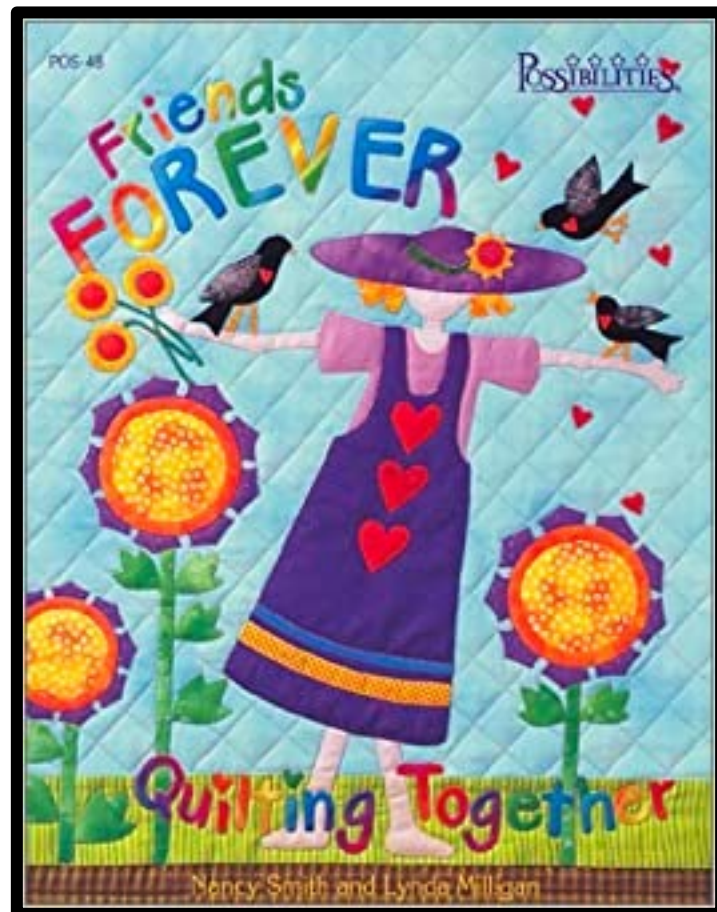


SIT AND SEW

The top and bottom rows of this quilt are based on the Choppy Flying Geese that I use in my Logo.

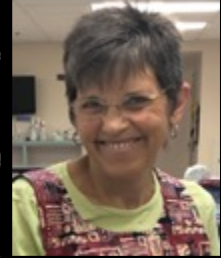

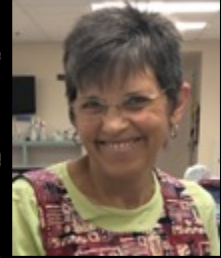

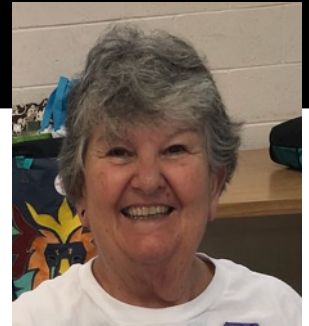

TRAVEL TO HAMILTON FOR RETREAT OCTOBER 22-25, 2024



There is still time to join the group traveling to Hamilton Missouri for the Seaside Sewing with Friends Retreat" October 22-25, 2024. Currently 22 will be making the journey.

A meet and greet will be held Sunday September 8, 2024 for the San Diego group.

Retreat Date: October 22-25, 2024. October 22, 2024, is check in day with first meal in the evening with open sew after. Early arrival is available for Monday October 21, 2024, for an additional \$50 and if flying from San Diego you will need the early arrival to be able to make the orientation on Tuesday October 22, 2024.

Retreat Fee: \$450 which includes dorm -style sleeping accommodation (2-5 per room and shared bathroom), 8 meals, coffee station, a sewing room with individual tables, as well as irons and cutting stations.

Sewing Machine: Babylock sewing machines are available at no additional cost when arranged at the time of reservation. So, you only bring your personal sewing supplies.

Early Check In: Available on Monday for an additional \$50. If you don't know your travel plans at the time of registration so didn't choose early check-in let Jo know and she can contact our MSQ contact to add early registration to your account. If flying from San Diego you will need the early arrival to be able to make the orientation on Tuesday October 22, 2024.

Travel Arrangements: Each participant is responsible for making their own travel arrangements. Flights from San Diego to Kansas City, Missouri our currently open on Southwest. Transportation arrangements from the airport to Hamilton can be arranged or rental car options.

Accommodation: Rooms in the retreat center sleep between 3-5. No bunk beds. Six dormitory style bathrooms are on the second floor. Two handicapped rooms are available on the lower level with reservations by special arrangement.

Projects Presented by MSQ: If you don't have a project to work on during this retreat MSQ will be demonstrating two patterns that can be done during the retreat. The patterns presented will be Lakeview Terrace (jelly roll friendly) and Boardwalk (10" precut friendly). The fabric requirements are given at the time you register so you can bring your fabric with you OR of course you have time to shop before the retreat starts.

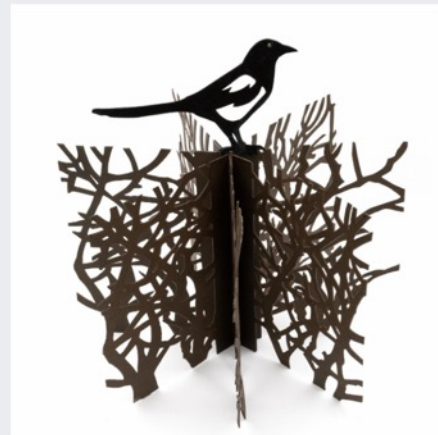
