JANUARY 6TH MEETING KAREN BOLAN




Welcome! I'm Karen Bolan, a quilter, teacher, and pattern designer.

Lecture: Learn with Every Quilt

Every quilt is a learning experience. This lecture catalogs my quilting journey through the lessons learned from my quilts. View a gallery of original quilts while we take an entertaining stroll through my development as a modern quilter. While I learned some lessons from renowned teachers, others I learned the hard way! Get ready for a few laughs and a lot of good advice; whether you choose to follow is up to you. This is a 45-minute lecture plus about 15 minutes for Q&A throughout.



Workshop: Special Effects with Color

Journey into color mastery by creating illusions and tricking the eye. Color is one of the most exciting things about quilting, and yet it's easy to feel unsure about our choices. By understanding how we see color and then creating illusions with color, students can develop color confidence and giddy enjoyment. In this class, learn to define and use basic color theory terminology; apply the principles of additive and subtractive color as they relate to vision, light, and the physical world; create mutable color illusions; create a color palette with afterimage effects; and create transparency illusions including a complex transparency illusion with more than two overlapping shapes and textures.

Students will learn to create three different categories of color effects: mutable color, transparency, and afterimage effect. As a three-hour class, it is a no-sew class with instructive lecture, discussion, and ample time for practice and personal attention. As a six-hour class, students also sew a small sampler.

Looking forward to seeing you at the January meeting with your UFO's!



The January workshop will be on the fourth Tuesday of the month --- January 27. My husband is having minor surgery on the 20th, and I need to drive him back and forth. The third week of January is plenty busy – most of the guild is taking the bus trip to quilt show in Ontario.

The children of San Diego continue to benefit from all your hard work. A big group of wonderful quilters came to the workshop in December, and we got so much done. We spent 5 hours organizing all the fabric in the Guild stash in my garage. Boxes are grouped by color and by size (half a yard, one yard and big enough for a backing). There is a stack of shoe box size boxes of scraps. I know – it's a sickness – we can't throw anything away. We are talking about 20 linear feet of storage. It feels so good to have a handle on what is out there. There are four large tubs of children's novelty fabric, along with a fabric shop supply of companion fabrics, solids and stipes, and polka dots and anything else you may need. Please, if anyone is making quilts for charity, please come get some of this adorable fabric.

Behind every quilter is a huge pile of fabric they 'might use someday.

DEAR JANE QUILT BLOCK OF THE MONTH 2 YEAR PROJECT

STARTED IN OCTOBER 2025



Hi all-

As discussed at the recent QTYW, we will have a catch-up month for December, so no new blocks to complete. YAY!

Now that I am working on my blocks (yes, I got a late start), I have a couple of notes to share.

1. I am not adding the sashing shown in the Hobby Stash Patterns. That sashing does not make sense to me. I will add sashing later.
2. Without the sashing on each of my blocks, my unfinished blocks are finishing at 5 inches square.
3. In the Dear Jane book and the actual Dear Jane quilt, the border triangles have the background fabric on the outside edges, but at least one (if not more) of the Holly Stash triangle patterns show the print on the outside edge of the triangle with the background used in the middle pieces. Make sure you are putting your background and print fabrics in the locations that you want. I would hate for you to have to remake a triangle (Like I am doing).
