## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

This is my final newsletter article as your President. It's been a whirlwind two years. I started as your President without ever attending a board meeting. Very quickly I learned that we needed the board to focus on the fiduciary responsibilities of the guild while the committee chairs focused on all the fun activities (which still amounted to a lot of work) that we all get to enjoy. For those of you who haven't been following the business side of the guild here is a summary.

A non-profit in the state of California like ours, typically must file a dozen or so documents with the state or the federal government every year. Complicating matters, some documents are filed every other year. More documents are required for more speakers. It's all quite confusing, and the state is SLOW (think of the Sloth at the DMV in the Zootopia movie) to respond. It didn't help that we hadn't filed some paperwork for over five years, we then used an outdated form to update our status, and the state mailed letters to a man who is not one of our members. In summary, it took us two years to regain our official Non-profit status and permission to conduct raffles.

So how do we make sure this doesn't happen again? Four key solutions:

1. Past President sits on board for two years to provide continuity to new board
2. Calendar of board requirements by month was drafted and stored on our Google drive. It is reviewed every month by the board
3. Physical Post Office box was purchased and maintained for state communications
4. Assistant Treasurer role was created to ensure continuity with the Treasurer when submitting paperwork.

There are many other accomplishments of our board and committee chairs these past two years. I will highlight many of them at our June meeting. For now, I want to thank everyone for always stepping up despite the challenges.

So, what's next for me? Disneyland? No! Instead, I am looking forward to finishing many UFOs next year!

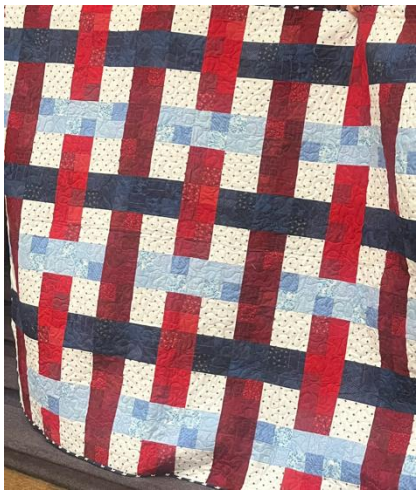
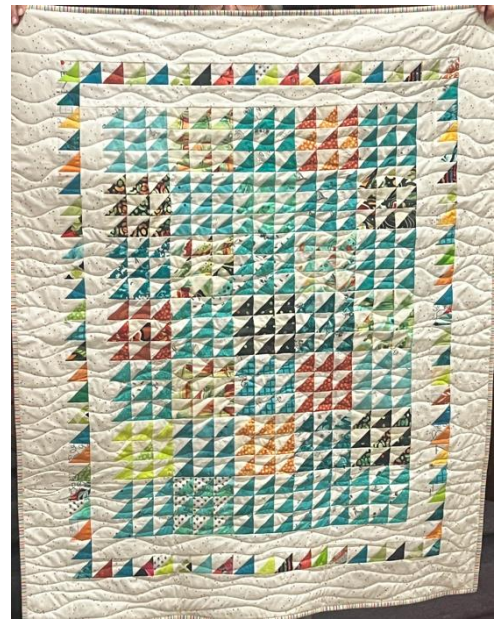
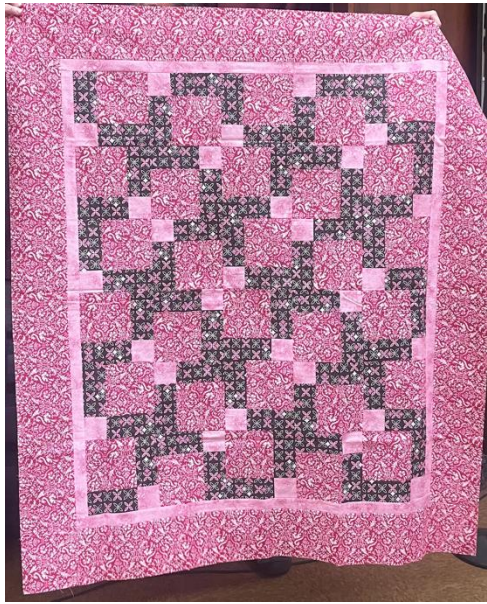

## BEGGER'S SQUARE



## BEGGER'S SQUARE due June 2026 mtg

White Fabric:: Cut one 3.25-inch square, Cut one strip 1.5 inches wide and 30 inches long.

Colored/Design Fabric:: Cut 2 strips 1.5 inches wide and 30 inches long.

**Step one** – Sew the 1.5 strips together with the white strip in the middle.

**Step two** – Cut the joined Strip into 3.25 inches wide squares.

**Step three** – Lay out as shown in picture and sew together!

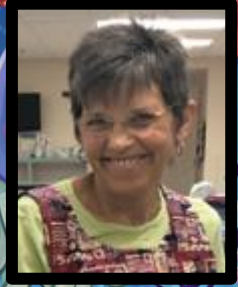

**Let the fun begin!!**

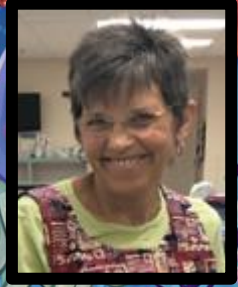

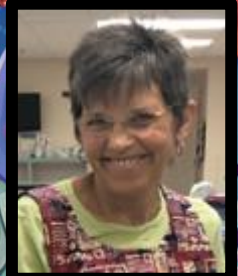

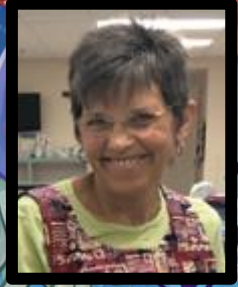
